Adrian Nalasco was appointed as Director, Nuclear Supply at the Ontario Ministry of Energy on March 1, 2016. Adrian has over 15 years of experience in policy development and government decision-making.

Adrian joined the Ministry of Energy in September 2015 as Director, Special Projects. In this role, he provided strategic leadership and advice to support the government's approval of an updated refurbishment agreement with Bruce Power, proceeding with the refurbishment of Darlington generating station and a plan to seek regulatory approvals for the ongoing operation of Pickering generating station.

Prior to joining the Ministry of Energy, Adrian held the position of Director, Electricity Finance at the Ontario Ministry of Finance since June 2013 and worked for years prior as a senior manager in the same branch. During his tenure, Adrian led a team of policy professionals to provide analysis and advice on the fiscal impact of Ontario Power Generation and Hydro One on the Province including the execution and risks of major nuclear projects.

Adrian has held progressively senior positions in the Ministry of Finance since August 2000, specializing in analysis and advice on the financial, economic and regulatory aspects of Ontario's electricity sector.

Adrian has a Bachelor's degree in Economics from Wilfrid Laurier University and a Master's degree in Economics from University of Toronto.
