ANTONY (TONY) MORRIS

Tony is fully engaged in delivering SNC-Lavalin Nuclear's growth strategy through the capture of niche nuclear new-build opportunities and deployment of innovative, high value nuclear services to international markets.

He has over 40-years' experience of nuclear operations, nuclear business management in the United Kingdom, United States and Canada and was part of the team that acquired the Bruce Nuclear Generating Station in Ontario & the AmerGen nuclear assets in the United States.

Tony started his career in the Chemical and Polymer industry, is a Chartered Chemist and a Member of the Royal Society of Chemistry. From a nuclear station background, he moved into consultancy appointed as the European Union's Technical Nuclear Advisor to the Ukrainian Ministry of Nuclear Power in the mid-nineties.

On arrival in Canada he was involved in the development of the proposal for the acquisition of the nuclear plants in Ontario that ultimately led to the formation of Bruce Power in 2001. He has experience on both the buy & sell side of nuclear power plants and has developed business cases for the application of SMR process heat technology for low-carbon in-situ bitumen extraction in the Oil Sands. More recently, he has delivered nuclear new build proposals and has proposed a CANDU solution for reuse of the UK's stockpiles of plutonium and recovered uranium.
